## **BAKED GOODS CONTEST RULES**

- ❖ Entries must be brought to the Crossroads Arena on **Thursday, September 14<sup>th</sup> from 9 a.m. until noon.**
- ❖ Participants can enter as many entries as they want.
- ❖ All entries must be wrapped in see-thru (plastic) wrap.
- ❖ Each entry must be displayed on sturdy, disposable containers. If you bring your entry in a covered cake or pie dish, you will need to remove the entry and take the covered carrier with you. The fair committee is not responsible for lost or stolen dishes.
- ❖ Registration will occur by number only. Each participant will be provided a number at registration and all of his/her entries will be numbered respectively.
- ❖ Entries will be judged according to the Modified Danish System.
- ❖ Items requiring refrigeration are **NOT** eligible for entry into the contest. (Ice cream, cream cheese frosting, buttermilk pie, etc.)
- ❖ **ALL ENTRIES BECOME PROPERTY OF THE ALCORN COUNTY FAIR.**
- ❖ Ribbons may be picked up on Monday, September 18th at the Crossroads Arena office.

### **AWARDS:**

Blue, Red and White ribbons will be awarded.

A “Best of Show” ribbon will be awarded in each Division.
